"SANTIAGO" COAT


ADRIAFIL[®]
Filati dal 1911 - Made in Italy




D&R n° 69

Size: one size (fits size S/M/L)
Intermediate

Materials: Adriafile Diletta ash (27) 9 balls, emerald (23) 4 balls, plum (25) 4 balls, wood (26) 3 balls, milk (20) 3 balls, 1 **size 4 mm (G6US-8UK)** crochet hook. You can also use Primula Adriafile yarn.

Tension: 1 crochet Granny square = 10x10 cm (4x4"). Take time to check tension and switch hook if necessary.

Stitches:

Crochet chain, Slip st, Double crochet, Treble crochet, Backwards crochet = work Double crochet moving from left to right.

Color pattern:

- 1- milk – emerald – plum – ash 24 Granny squares
- 2- milk – wood – emerald – ash 22 Granny squares
- 3- milk – plum – wood – ash 24 Granny squares
- 4- milk – plum – emerald – ash 22 Granny squares
- 5- milk – plum – ash 10 Granny squares
- 6- milk – wood – ash 11 Granny squares
- 7- milk – emerald – ash 11 Granny squares

Start each Granny square using milk and finish using ash. Whenever 3 colors are mentioned, work the 2nd and 3rd round using the same color.

Directions:

Chain 8 sts, then join with a Slip st in this and all following rounds.

1st round: 3 Chain sts, (= 1st Treble crochet), 2 Treble crochet left unworked (with 3 loops on hook, draw through all loops at once), 3 Chain sts, 3 Treble crochet left unworked (with 4 loops on hook, draw through all loops at once), 1 Chain st, * 3 Treble crochet left unworked, 3 Chain sts, 3 Treble crochet left unworked, 1 Chain st, repeat from * 2 more times.

2nd round: * [Treble crochet 3 tog, 2 Chain sts, Treble crochet 3 tog] into the next ch-3 space, 2 Chain sts, 3 Treble crochet into the ch-1 space, 2 Chain sts, repeat from * 3 more times.

3rd round: * [Treble crochet 3 tog, 2 Chain sts, Treble crochet 3 tog] into the next ch-2 space, 2 Chain sts, 2 Treble crochet into the next ch-2 space, 1 Treble crochet into each of the following 3 Treble crochet, 2 Treble crochet into the next ch-2 space, 2 Chain sts, repeat from * 3 more times.

4th round: Repeat the 3rd round. Fasten off. Following color pattern, work 124 Granny squares.

Finishing: Weave in ends. Joining the squares of right front, back and left front: Lay out 12 Granny squares (3 for right front, 6 for back and 3 for left front) side by side and sew them together using ash. Evenly distribute the colors following color pattern. Sew 7 strips on top of each other, for armholes leaving 25 cm (9 7/8") unsewn. You have 84 Granny squares. Sew each shoulder seam over 20 cm (7 7/8"). Joining of the sleeves: lay out 5 Granny squares side by side and sew them together. Sew 4 strips together and sew the seam. You have 20 Granny squares per sleeve. Using ash work 1 row Double crochet and 1 row

Backwards crochet along vertical edge of right front, neck and left front. Ensure that garment maintains its shape.

Using ash work 1 row Double crochet and 1 row Backwards crochet along lower edge of sleeves. Sew in the sleeves.
