"VANCOUVER" PULLOVER

Size: S/M – L/XL
Level: Expert

Materials: AdriaFil Romanzo emerald (41) 8-9-9-10 balls, **size 4 mm (6US-8UK)** and **4,5 mm (7US-7UK)** knitting needles.

Tension: Using size 4 needles, 22 sts and 26 rows in Stocking st = 10x10 cm (4x4"). Take time to check tension and switch needles if necessary.

Stitches:

Stocking st: on right side knit, on wrong side purl.
2x2 Ribbing: 1st row: alternately K2, P2.
2nd row: knit into knit, purl into purl. Repeat the 2nd row.

Instructions: Begin with the base row A until you have 3 triangles (= 1st row) .* Now work the left-side triangle B 1 time, then the right-leaning square B and the right triangle B 1 time (= 2nd row). Then work the left-leaning square C 3 times (= 3rd row). Repeat rows B (= 4th row), C (= 5th row) and then 1 time B (= 6th row). Finish with the top edge triangle (= 7th row). You obtain the different knit directions while knitting.

Back: Cast on 66-75 sts loosely (= 3 sets of 22-25 sts) and work as follows:

A: Base row. To make the picking up of sts easy, use the Edge st.

1st row (right side): Knit the first 22-25 sts (= right side).
2nd row: Purl this row and all following even rows.
3rd row: Slip 1 st (= Edge st), K1, turn.
5th row: slip 1 st, K2, turn.
7th row: slip 1 st, K3, turn.
9th row: slip 1 st, K4, turn.
11th row: slip 1 st, K5, turn.
Row 13 through to row 41-47: Repeat the 11th row, always increasing 1 extra knit stitch (= 6, then 7, 8 sts etc).
43rd-49th row: slip 1 st, K21-K24, do not turn. This is the first triangle of the base row.

Second and following triangle: repeat these 43-49 rows. Leave the knitted triangle on hold on the RH needle. (You have 3 triangles).

B: left-side triangle:

1st row (wrong side): K1, turn.
2nd row: work 2 sts into this stitch (you have 2 sts), turn.
3rd row: K1, P2 tog, turn.
4th row: K1, increase 1 st by picking up the horizontal strand between sts and knitting it through backloop, K1, turn.
5th row: K1, P1, P2 tog, turn.
6th and all even rows: knit to the last st, increase 1 st, K1, turn.
7th row: K1, P2, P2 tog, turn.
9th row: K1, P3, P2 tog, turn.

Row 11 through to 41-47: repeat the 9th row, always increasing 1 extra purl st (= 4, then 5, 6 sts etc.) until 23-26 sts remain.
43rd-49th row: K1, P20-P23, P2 tog, do not turn.

B: Right-leaning square:

1st row (= wrong side): pick up 22-25 sts, as follows: always pick up a stitch along the sts of the 3rd triangle and purl them. Place the last st back onto LH needle and purl it together with the next st. Turn.
2nd and all even rows: K22-K25 (= right side).
3rd and all odd rows (= wrong side): slip 1 st, P20-P23, P2 tog, turn.
43rd-49th row: slip 1 st, P20-P23, P2 tog, do not turn. Repeat row 1 through to 43-49 to make the next square. You have 2 squares.

B: right-side triangle:

1st row: pick up 22-25 sts (= wrong side), turn.
2nd and all even rows: knit across, turn.
3rd row: slip 1 st, P19-P22, P2 tog, turn.
5th row: slip 1 st. P18-P21, P2 tog, turn.

Row 7 through to 39-45: repeat the 5th row, always working 1 purl stitch less (= 17 and then 16, 15 sts etc.). Turn.
41st-47th row: slip 1 st, P2 tog, turn.
43rd-49th row: P2 tog.

C: Left-leaning square:

1st row (right side): place the last st of the right-side triangle onto RH needle, this is the first st, then pick up 21-24 sts along side edge of right-side triangle. Place the last st onto LH needle and knit it together with the next st. Turn.
2nd row: P22-P25, turn.
3rd row: slip 1 st, K20-K23, work 2 sts tog, turn.
4th and all even rows: purl, turn.
5th and all odd rows: slip 1 st, K20-K23, work 2 sts tog, turn.

Following squares: repeat as indicated above. You have 3 squares.



To obtain the right length repeat the rows B, C and finish with B.

Top edge triangle:

1st row (right side): pick up 21-24 sts, place the last st onto LH needle, K2 tog, turn (= 22-25 sts).
2nd and all following even rows: purl, turn.
3rd row: K2 tog, K19-K22, place the last st onto LH needle, K2 tog, turn.
5th row: K2 tog, K18-K21, place the last st onto LH needle, K2 tog, turn.
Row 7 through to 39-45: repeat the 5th row, always working 1 knit st less (= first 17, then 16, 15 sts etc.).
41st-47th row: K2 tog, place the last st onto LH needle, K2 tog, turn.
43rd-49th row: slip 1 st, place the last st onto LH needle, K2 tog, pass the slipped st over the 2 sts worked tog. The remaining stitch is the first st of the next triangle, do not turn.
Repeat these rows for the next triangles.

Front: Work same as back.

Sleeves: Work same as back, but only work rows A, B, C and finish with B.



Finishing: Border: using size 4,5 needles pick up 114-122 sts along lower and upper edge of front and back and work in 2x2 Ribbing. After finishing 5 cm (2") bind off (cast off) the sts in 2x2 Ribbing. Sew the shoulder seams, for neck opening leaving approx. the center 40 cm (15 3/4") unsewn. Sleeve cuff: using size 4,5 needles pick up 68-73 sts along lower edge of sleeves and work as follows (= wrong side): P2, * K4, P2, repeat from * until end of row, on wrong side row work sts as they appear (= right side). After finishing 14 rows decrease 11 sts (= P2 tog) by turning P4 into P3. Work 14 rows and continue to decrease 11 sts by turning P3 into P2. Work 6 more rows, then bind off (cast off) sts in 2x2 Ribbing. Sew in the sleeves, matching center of sleeve to shoulder seam. Sew side and underarm seams. Shape garment by laying it out to measurement under a damp cloth or gently pressing it.
