



Size: S – M – L

Materials: AdriaFil Nature red (17) 4-5-5 balls, orange (35) 3-4-4 balls, yellow (53) 3-4-4 balls, white (02) 3-3-4 balls, brown (50) 2 balls, lilac (43) 3 balls, size 5 knitting needles

Gauge: 19 sts and 22 rows in Jacquard pattern = 10x10 cm. Take time to check gauge and switch needles if necessary.

Stitches:

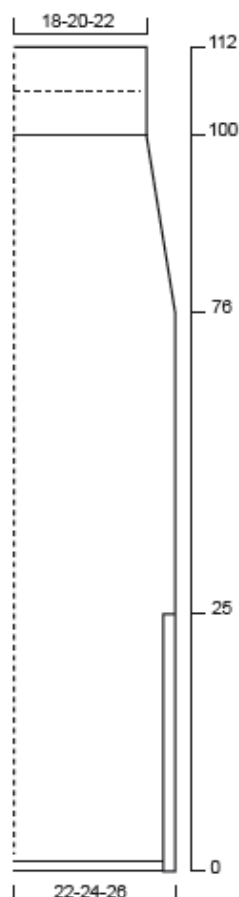
2x2 Ribbing: alternately K2 and P2.

Jacquard pattern: work in Stockinette st, following chart. Each square is one stitch wide and one row long. Continue repeating 12 sts (width) and 11 rows (length). Begin each new color with 8th row in chart. Colors overlap each other.

Stripe pattern: *orange, yellow, white, brown, lilac, red, repeat from *.

Directions:

Front: Using red cast on 83-91-99 sts and work 3 rows in 2x2 Ribbing. Continue working in Jacquard pattern, beginning with stitch marked A-B-C in chart, allowing the 4 bottom rows with open squares to continue in red and start chart using color as mentioned in Stripe pattern. Split: when work measures 25 cm, at right edge cast 3 extra sts onto needle. Waist: when work measures 76 cm decrease 8 times 1 st at both edges, every 6 rows. Decrease as follows: 1 edge st, slip 1 st, work 1 st and PSSO, work to the last 3 sts, K2 tog, 1 edge st. When work measures 100 cm, using red continue in 2x2 Ribbing, evenly decreasing in the 1st row to obtain 70-78-86 sts. When work measures 112 cm (or desired length), bind off all sts loosely in 2x2 Ribbing.



Back: Work same as front, reversing all shaping.

Finishing: Using red pick up approx. 50 sts along front split and work 3 rows in 2x2 Ribbing. Work a second border along back split. Sew side seams. Fold upper border in half and sew it to the inside, making sure that seam can stretch.
