Sizes: S/M – L/XL

The smallest size is given first and the largest size follows separated by a dash. Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes.

Bust circumference: 104-112 cm (40¹⁵/₁₆-44³/₈”).

Front/Back length: 60-65 cm (23⁵/₈-25⁹/₁₆”).

Inner sleeve length: 22-23 cm (8¹¹/₁₆-9¹/₁₆”).

Materials: Adriafil Totalino beige (61): 6-7 balls (= yarn A), Adriafil Totalino aqua (56): 6-7 balls (= yarn B); size 3 mm (11UK) and size 4 mm (8UK-6US) straight knitting needles.

Patterns and stitches:

Garter stitch: knit all rows.

Openwork stitch (number of sts divisible by 7):

Row 1 (RS): *K5, Yo, skp (= slip 1 st knitwise, K1, pass slipped st over), repeat from * to end of row.

Row 2: knit.

Row 3: *K4, K2tog, Yo, K1, repeat from * to end of row.

Row 4: knit.

Always repeat Rows 1-4.

Stripe sequence: alternate colours foll directions.

Note: on all RS rows work 1st st with both colours (= yarn A + yarn B).

Tension: 16 sts and 40 rows in openwork stitch using size 4 mm needles = 10x10 cm (4x4”).

Take time to check tension and change needles if necessary.

Directions:

Note: for all parts work 1st st with both colours (= yarn A + yarn B) also on Row 1.

Back: pattern is worked sideways from left side to right side.

Using size 4 mm needles and yarn A cast on 63-70 sts and work in openwork stitch and stripe sequence as follows, beginning with 1 RS row: 6-7 rows using yarn A, *10 rows using yarn B, 2 rows using yarn A, 2 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 14 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, repeat from * twice more, 10 rows using yarn B, 2 rows using yarn A, 2 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 6-14 rows using yarn B, 0-7 rows using yarn A (= 208-224 rows).

At the same time, when work measures 2.5 cm (6³/₆₄”), for left armhole, at the end of next RS row cast on 1 st, then cast on every other row once 1 st, once 2 sts, once 3 sts and once 28 sts (= 98-105 sts). Work increased sts into pattern.

Work straight.

When work measures 47-51 cm (18¹/₂-20¹/₁₆”), for right armhole, at the beginning of next WS row cast off 28 sts, then every other row once 3 sts, once 2 sts and twice 1 st (= 63-70 sts).

Work straight.

When work measures 52-56 cm (22¹/₁₆”), cast off all sts.

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Left Front: pattern is worked sideways from Left Front opening to Left Front side.

Using size 4 mm needles and yarn A cast on 86-93 sts and work in openwork stitch and stripe sequence as follows, beginning with 1 RS row: 4-8 rows using yarn A, 10 rows using yarn B, 2 rows using yarn A, 2 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 14 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 10 rows using yarn B, 2 rows using yarn A, 2 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 4-8 rows using yarn B (= 92-100 rows.).

At the same time, when work measures 4 cm ($1\frac{9}{16}$ "), for neckline, at the end of next RS row cast on 2 sts, then every other row 5 times 2 sts (= 98-105 sts). Work straight.

When work measures 18-20 cm ($7\frac{1}{16}$ - $7\frac{7}{8}$ "), for armhole, at the beginning of next WS row cast off 28 sts, then every other row once 3 sts, once 2 sts and twice 1 st (= 63-70 sts).

Work straight.

When work measures 23-25 cm ($9\frac{1}{16}$ - $9\frac{13}{16}$ "), cast off all sts.

Right Front: pattern is worked sideways from Right Front side to Right Front opening.

Using size 4 mm needles and yarn B cast on 63-70 sts, work in openwork stitch and stripe sequence as follows, beginning with 1 RS row: 4-8 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 10 rows using yarn B, 2 rows using yarn A, 2 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 14 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 10 rows using yarn B, 2 rows using yarn A, 2 rows using yarn B, 4-8 rows using yarn A (= 92-100 rows.).

At the same time, when work measures 2.5 cm ($\frac{63}{64}$ "), for armhole, at the end of next RS row cast on 1 st, then cast on every other row once 1 st, once 2 sts, once 3 sts and once 28 sts (= 98-105 sts). Work increased sts into pattern.

Work straight.

When work measures 17-19 cm ($6\frac{11}{16}$ - $7\frac{1}{2}$ "), for neckline, at the beginning of next WS row cast off 2 sts, then every other row 5 times 2 sts (= 86-93 sts).

When work measures 23-25 cm ($9\frac{1}{16}$ - $9\frac{13}{16}$ "), cast off all sts.

Right Sleeve: pattern is worked sideways starting from underarm edge.

Using size 4 mm needles and yarn B cast on 35-37 sts and work in openwork stitch and stripe sequence as follows, beginning with 1 RS row (**note: for size L/XL** work 1 selvedge st at each end): 14 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 10 rows using yarn B, 2 rows using yarn A, 2 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 14 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 10 rows using yarn B, 2 rows using yarn A, 2 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 14 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 10 rows using yarn B, 2 rows using yarn A, 2 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A (= 168 rows.).

At the same time, when work measures 6 cm ($2\frac{3}{8}$ ") (= you have worked 24 rows), for sleeve cap, at the end of next RS row cast on 1 st, then on foll 8th row 1 st, on foll 6th row 1 st, every 4th row 3 times 1 st and on foll 2nd row 1 st (= 42-44 sts). Work increased sts into pattern. You have worked 54 rows.

Work straight for 60 more rows.

When work measures 28.5 cm ($11\frac{1}{4}$ ") (= you have worked 114 rows), at the beginning of next WS row, cast off 1 st, then on foll 2nd row 1 st, every 4th row 3 times 1 st, on foll 6th row 1 st, on foll 8th row 1 st (= 35-37 sts). Work straight.

When work measures 42 cm ($16\frac{9}{16}$ "), cast off all sts.

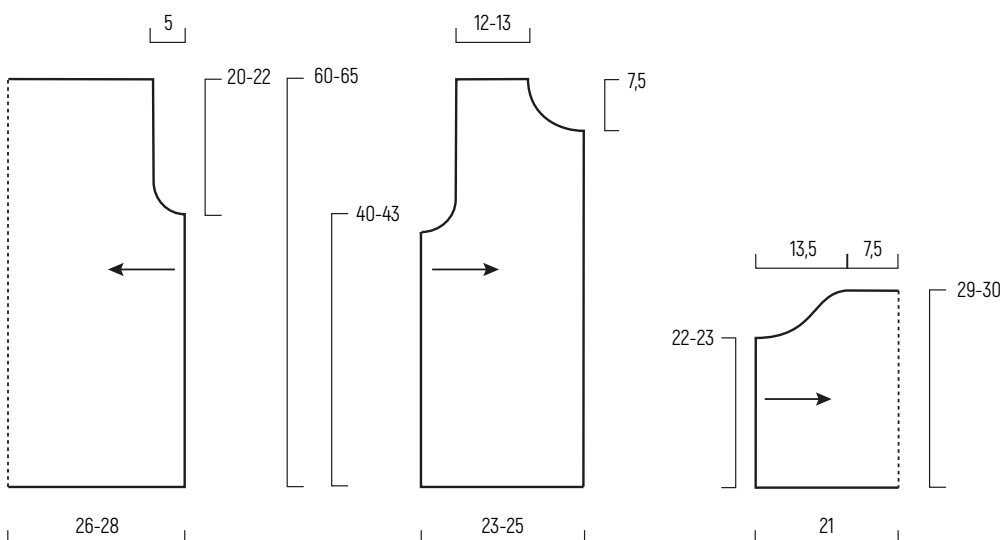
Left Sleeve: work as given for Right sleeve, but alternating colours as follows: 14 rows using yarn A, 10 rows using yarn B, 2 rows using yarn A, 2 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 14 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 10 rows using yarn B, 2 rows using yarn A, 2 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 14 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 10 rows using yarn B, 2 rows using yarn A, 2 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 14 rows using yarn B.

Collar: using size 4 mm needles and yarn A cast on 9 sts and work in openwork stitch and stripe sequence as follows, beginning with 1 RS row (note: for all sizes work 1 selvedge st at each end): 4 rows using yarn A, *10 rows using yarn B, 2 rows using yarn A, 2 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 14 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, repeat from * once more, 10 rows using yarn B, 2 rows using yarn A, 2 rows using yarn B, 14 rows using yarn A, 14 rows using yarn B, 8 rows using yarn A (= 166 rows). Cast off all sts.

Front band (make 2): using size 3 mm needles and yarn A cast on 7 sts and work 50-57 cm ($19\frac{11}{16}$ - $22\frac{7}{16}$ ") in garter stitch, then cast off all sts.

Finishing:

Sew shoulder, side and underarm seams. Set in sleeves. Sew collar to neckline. Sew 1 Front band to Right Front opening and 1 Front band to Left Front opening, stretching slightly.




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
